Revenue Protection Act, No.19 of 1962

Order

By virtue of the powers vested in me by under Section 2 of the Revenue Protection Act, No. 19 of 1962, I, Mangala Samaraweera, Minister of Finance, the Democratic Socialistic Republic of Sri Lanka, do by this Order from .12th June , 2019, require the Director General of Customs to demand and levy on each article specified in Column 3 of the Schedule hereto, import duty at the general rate set out in the corresponding entry in Column 5 of that Schedule or where a preferential rate is leviable and payable under the Provisions of Schedule "A" of the Customs Ordinance (Chapter 235), at the preferential rate set out in the corresponding entry in Column 4 of that Schedule.
