

## GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION

### Imports and Exports Control Act, No. 1 of 1969

IN terms of the powers vested in me by Section 20 read together with Sub-Section 4(1) and Section 14 of the Imports and Exports (Control) Act, No. 1 of 1969 as amended by Act, No. 48 of 1985 and Act, No. 28 of 1987, I, Ranil Wickremesinghe, the Minister of Finance, Economic Stabilization and National Policies promulgate following Regulations.

### REGULATIONS

1. These Regulations may be cited as the “**Imports and Exports (Control) Regulations No. 02 of 2023**”.
2. The Imports and Exports (Control) Regulations No. 02 of 2023, published in the Gazette Extraordinary No. 2312/78 dated January 01, 2023, as amended and as last amended by the Imports and Exports (Control) Regulations No. 09 of 2023, published in the Gazette Extraordinary No. 2335/26 dated June 09, 2023, is hereby further amended.
  - 2.1 Goods, classified under the HS Codes as described in the Schedule below, which is an integral part of this Regulation, together with their corresponding entries shall be deleted from the **Schedule I** of the Imports and Exports (Control) Regulations No. 02 of 2023, as referred above.

2.2 The Director General, Sri Lanka Customs is hereby authorized to release any cargo / consignment of goods, classified under the HS Codes as referred in the Regulation No. 2.1 above; and arrived at any Port / Airport of Sri Lanka during the period of April 16, 2020, to July .19., 2023 violating the Imports and Exports Control Regulations on Temporary Suspension of importation of such goods; for which, no Customs Declaration (Bill of Entry / CUSDEC) has yet been submitted to the Sri Lanka Customs for the purpose of the provisions of the Government Revenue Protection (Special Provisions) Act, No. 01 of 2006; on the approval of the Controller General of Imports and Exports Control, subject to payment of **Additional Fee of 15% of the CIF Value** of such consignment/cargo to the Controller General of Imports and Exports Control.

2.3 The Regulation No. 8 (i) of the Imports and Exports (Control) Regulations No. 02 of 2023, referred in the Regulation No. 2 above, shall be deleted and substituted by the following new Regulation No. 8(i) and read as follows;

“8 (i) Importation of tiles, categorized under the HS Heading of 69.07 and listed out in the Schedule I of the said Regulations, for the purpose of direct usage, not for any forms of direct or indirect sale purpose, of any approved condominium or approved mix development projects or approved hotel projects or Government Projects (Consignee), which are not coming under the purview of the Board of Investment of Sri Lanka and under construction / renovation at the stage of laying of tiles for completion of such condominium or mix development or hotel projects or Government projects may be allowed by the Controller General of Imports and Exports Control subject to the limit of quantities of tiles as certified in the bill of quantities (BOQ) of such projects; under the payment terms of Letter of Credit or Document Against Acceptance, on recommendation of the Secretary to the Treasury and approval of the Minister in charge of subject of Finance, case by case basis.”

**2.4** The Regulation No. 8 (m) of the Imports and Exports (Control) Regulations No. 02 of 2023, referred in the Regulation No.2 above, as amended by the Imports and Exports (Control) Regulations No. 05 of 2023, published in the Gazette Extraordinary No. 2320/47 dated February 22, 2023, shall be deleted and substituted by the following new Regulation No. 8(m) and read as follows;

“8(m) Importation of Goods, classified under the HS Codes of **3305.10, 3305.20, and 3305.90** as listed out in the **Schedule I**, shall be allowed to import on prior approval of the Controller General of Imports and Exports, by any importer who has registered with the National Medicine Regulatory Authority (NMRA) and obtained Import License from the National Medicine Regulatory Authority (NMRA), subject to maximum value of importation of said goods, limited to 50% of the annual average Cost Insurance Freight (CIF) value, which will be calculated based on the imported value of the said goods during the period of last five (05) years of such importer.”

**3.** The Special Import License Regulations No. 01 of 2023, published in the Gazette Extraordinary No. 2312/77 dated January 01, 2023, as amended by the Imports and Exports Control Regulations No. 08 of 2023, published in the Gazette Extraordinary No. 2326/41 dated April 06, 2023, is hereby further amended.

- 3.1** Notwithstanding the Regulation No. 4 of the Imports and Exports Control Regulations No. 08 of 2023 referred above, importation of single-use plastic plates, cups, spoons, forks, knives and other cutlery instruments, classified under the HS Code of 3924.10.90, by a registered catering service provider for the purpose of servicing passengers on-board of international airlines, subject to prior approval of the Controller General of Imports and Exports.
- 4.** To achieve the objectives of these Regulations, the Controller General of Imports and Exports shall issue “Operational Instructions” to the Director General of Customs, licensed banks or any other relevant authorities.
  - 5.** The final decision shall be made by the Controller General of Imports and Exports on any issues arising in relation to these Regulations.
